

John was a much revered and respected member of our retriever community. John's impact on the retriever sports is far reaching and will continue to be felt for years to come. John was an avid amateur trainer and handler, colleague, confidant, mentor, advisor, judge and friend. John was the Central Region Vice-President of the inaugural Board of Directors of the MARC as well as co-chaired the inaugural 2017 MAI. His influence goes well beyond the scope of the MARC, as John held positions on several committees and boards, not the least of which are the 2008 Master National President, and a representative to the Retriever Hunt Test Advisory Committee. John was also a well-respected judge and judged the 2006 Master National in Morgan Hill, California.

If you ever ran under John, you have witnessed what we have come to call *"The Blackbird Kiss of Death."* When the wheels are coming off John would quietly step up behind you. He might whisper something like "That whistle isn't the Rosary, you better blow it." I am a retired USPS Rural Letter Carrier and now spend my time training my dog and throwing pottery.







The Training Property sites are open from 8 am to 5 pm.

- 1. The properties listed in the Training Guide are all private grounds. We are their guests and should act accordingly.
- 2. The use of these grounds shall be coordinated through the Hunt Test Committee and the random draws for property use.
- 3. No one may contact owners for individual or group use or access these properties except through the Hunt Test Committee.
- 4. The regulations listed for each property are in addition to these general guidelines.
- 5. Unless instructed otherwise close and secure all gates at all times.
- 6. Keep vehicles to the edges of fields and away from pond banks. Access fields only with UTV's or 4-wheelers and when wet walk into all grounds.

- 11. Dead birds must be disposed of in plastic bags in approved trash containers or may be dropped at the main Test Grounds where they will be disposed of properly.
