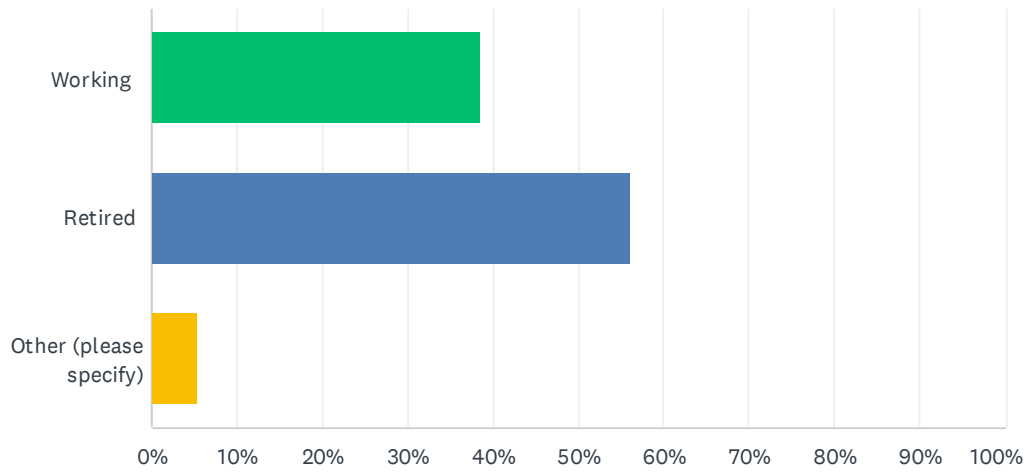


Q2 Are you working or retired?

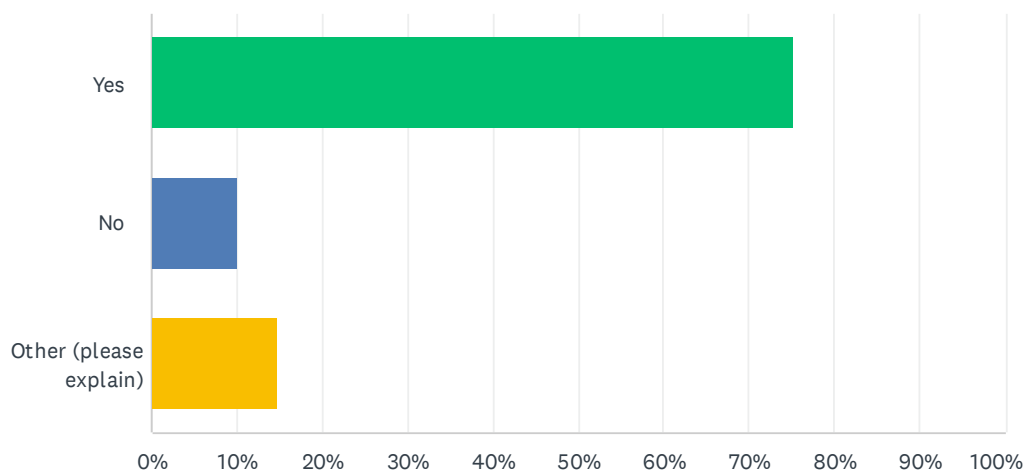

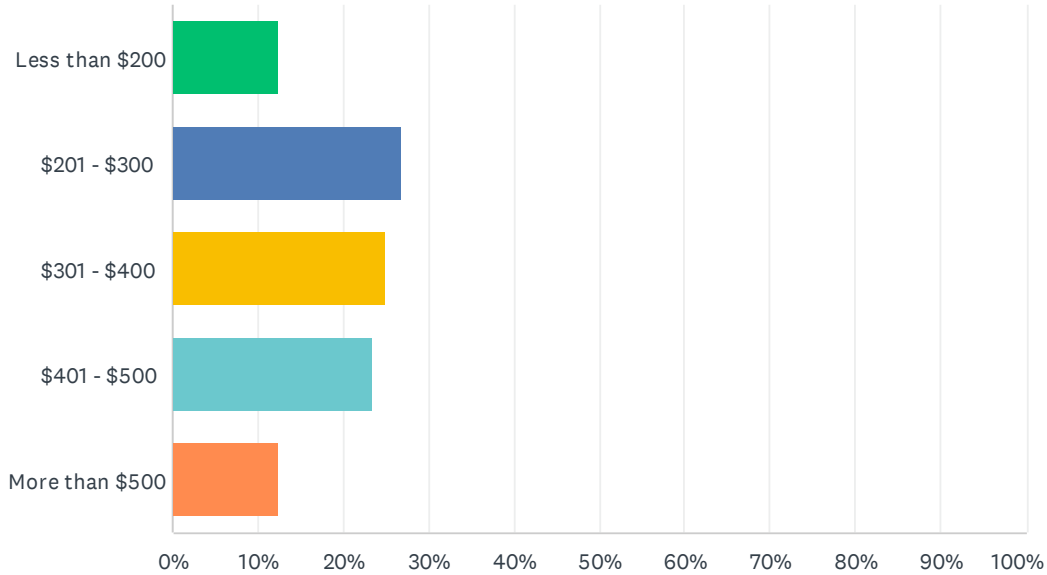

Q8 On average, how much do you spend per weekend out of town at a Hunt Test?

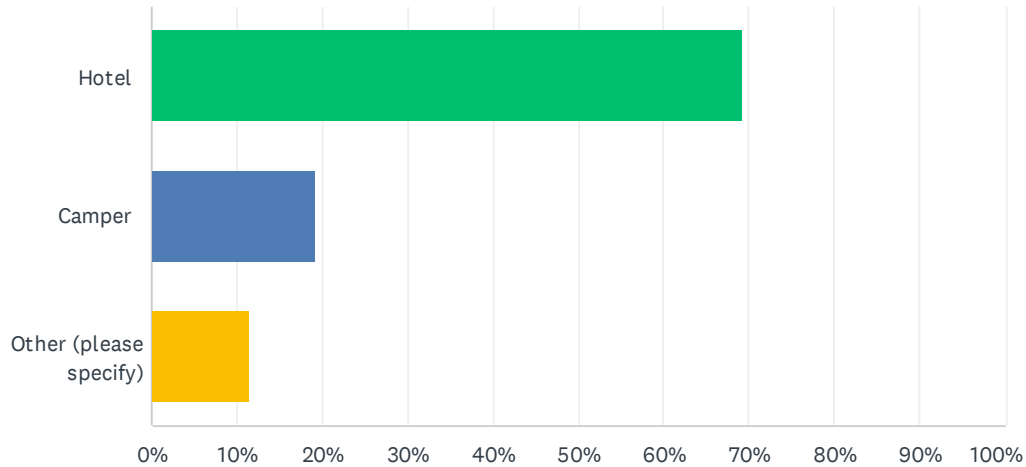
