• John O. Blackbird Memorial Award •

The retriever world lost a leader, a friend, a mentor and a staunch advocate with the unexpected passing of John Blackbird on September 9, 2017.

The purpose of the John O. Blackbird Memorial Award is two-fold. First, it is to honor, celebrate and perpetuate the life lived, the accomplishments, the lasting influence and legacy of John Blackbird.

Secondly, it is to honor a recipient who has demonstrated through their own work and efforts that they, too, have made significant contributions to the retriever hunting test program through training and handling retrievers as an amateur. Also, working and judging local hunting tests, being a leader in local, and perhaps regional or national clubs, and mentoring and supporting others in the retriever games.

The award will be presented at the MAI and may reflect the work a person does to work within or for the MARC and MAI or the effort to bring a dog to a national event. But, this award isn't just about a single event. This memorial/award is to recognize those folks that are cut from similar cloth as John Blackbird. An individual who not only shows up to an event and makes an impact, but also makes an impact on the retriever world throughout the years wherever they go. A person who is dedicated to the local clubs at the grassroots level, a "worker bee" when needed or a chair or secretary, someone who is a mentor to others, a person who trains and handles their own dogs to the highest level.

The work the individual does at the local level is perhaps even more important than what happens on the national stage. No person gets to a national event without going through a number of local weekend tests. What people do in their own backyard is paramount to their future success regardless of what stage or venue it may be.

CRITERIA

Please consider these criteria when making a nomination for this award. All

of these criteria need to be met for an individual to be considered for nomination.

- An amateur handler.
- Does not need to be a member of the MARC.
- Active in the retriever hunting test program as an amateur handler.
- Active in their local club(s) as a dedicated and reliable worker at events, serve in positions such as club officer, board member, event committee chairperson, secretary or committee member.
- Active as a retriever hunting test judge.
- Through one's individual efforts have made numerous and long lasting impacts for the betterment of the retriever sports/clubs/events.
- Consider other qualities, characteristics and personality, deemed appropriate.

HOW TO NOMINATE

Any person(s), regardless of MARC membership, can nominate an individual for this award. Multiple parties may nominate an individual and/or a club or group of clubs may submit a nomination.

Complete the Nomination Form lo-

cated on the MARC website at www.masteramateur.com, the MARC Facebook page or contact any member of the Master Amateur Board of Directors. There are two ways in which to submit the Nomination Form:

- 1) print, complete and mail the form to the contact outlined at the bottom of the nomination form OR
- 2) complete the digital nomination form found on the website.

The nomination form shall include the name of the nominee, the nominee's address, phone number and email, and list the nominee's home club(s). Also include a narrative of the accomplishments, leadership positions and other evidence, which supports the work, character and lasting impact the nominee has had on the retriever community.

The person(s) and/or club or group making the nomination must include their own personal contact information so the selection committee may reach out to them for further questions or details, if needed.

— Nominations are due no later than January 1st —

Nominations will be submitted to the Chairman of the John O. Blackbird Memorial Award Committee as appointed by the MARC Board of Directors.

After all nominations have been received, the MARC Board of Directors, and/or special committee, will review the nominations and supporting evidence and may also make separate inquiries vetting the nominees to determine the recipient of the award.

JOHN O. BLACKBIRD AWARD

The recipient will be announced at the Handler's Meeting/Opening Ceremonies of each MAI. There will be a "perpetual" plaque to be displayed at each MAI that will outline recipients names and years awarded. An individual award will also be presented to the recipient. The award recipient need not be present to receive the award.

• Important Information •

COVID-19

Welcome all handlers to the 2022 Master Amateur Invitational. Ensuring the safety and wellbeing of our handlers, judges and attendees is a priority. Currently, there are no COVID Restrictions in the state of Missouri or the town of Sedalia.

The board of the Master Amateur Retriever Club asks each handler and attendee to be respectful of the health of others. If you develop symptoms of COVID or Flu during the event, the board requests you to seek medical care at several urgent care facilities available in Sedalia. Tests can also be obtained through Walgreens and CVS. If a handler tests positive for COVID, the board asks the handler to find an alternative person to handle his/her dog or scratch the dog.

Masks will no longer be required during handlers' meetings or social events. The board respects the rights of individuals to determine personal safety precautions based upon their own health status and personal beliefs. If an individual wishes to wear a mask during the event, please feel free to do so.

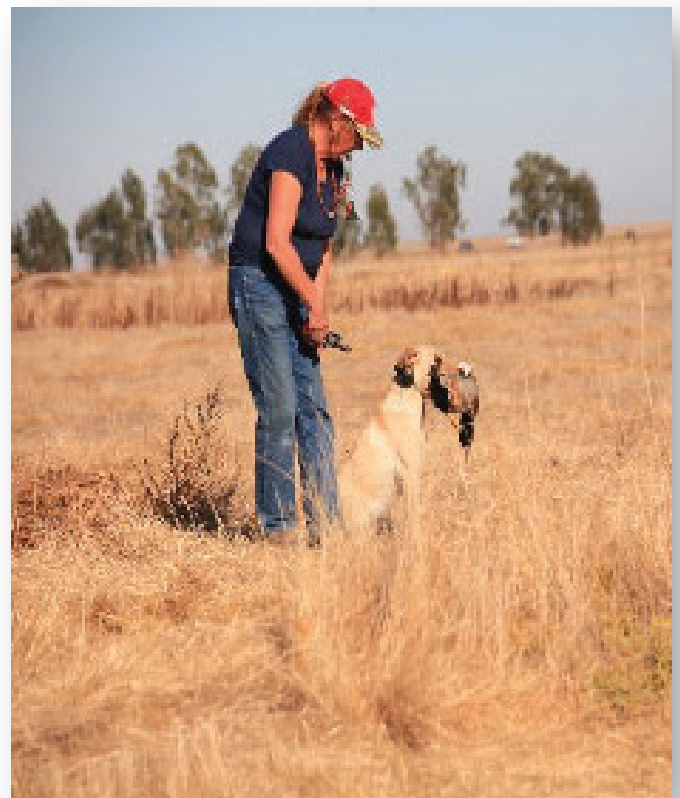

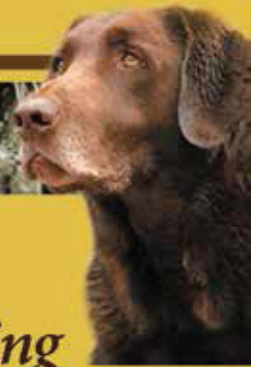

A Guide to the Use of 2022 MAI Training Properties

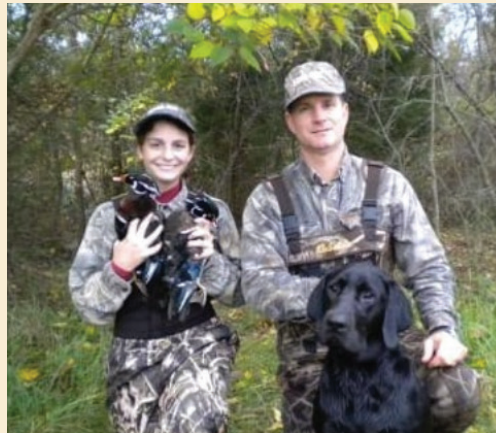
The following “Guidelines” list important considerations for the use of the pre invitational training grounds. Thanks to the generosity of the owners, these properties are available for our use. These are in no way meant to cover every possible consideration. When in doubt, use common sense and courtesy. Remember, we are invited guests on these properties. The training property sites are open from 8 am to 5 pm.

1. The properties listed in the training guide are all private grounds. We are their guests and should act accordingly.
2. The use of these grounds shall be coordinated through the Hunt Test Committee and the random draws for property use.
3. No one may contact owners for individual or group use or access these properties except through the Hunt Test Committee.
4. The regulations listed for each property are in addition to these general guidelines.
5. Unless instructed otherwise, close and secure all gates at all times.
6. **Keep vehicles to the edges of fields and away from pond banks. Access fields only with UTV's or 4-wheelers and when wet walk into all grounds.**
7. Be wary of livestock and neighbors. Never shoot in the direction of any visible livestock or residence.
8. **Unless otherwise noted, smoking on any property is prohibited, except in a closed vehicle.**
9. Remove all of your trash, including spent shells, dead birds and any other trash you find. Do not leave food scraps or spilled dog food on the grounds. Some properties specifically prohibit feeding on the grounds.
10. Stay well-away from residences.
11. Dead birds must be disposed of in plastic bags in approved trash containers or may be dropped at the main test grounds where they will be disposed of properly.
12. By entering any of these properties you acknowledge the risks inherent in outdoor sports whether such risks are apparent or hidden. All participants accept those risks and agree that they alone are responsible for the health and safety for themselves and others in their group. Participants, by their use of the properties, acknowledge that they hold the property owners, MARC, its officers and members harmless and free of any liability for any accidents, injuries or damage to their persons or vehicles. Entering any of the properties is further subject to the participants’ agreement to be held fully responsible for any damage, accidental or otherwise, to the property and any animals, facilities, buildings or equipment located on the property.
13. Enjoy these wonderful properties. But, please, be courteous to the landowners and their neighbors. Note: For all properties in the training guide – No driving trucks on pond dams. Please use ATVs or walk-in.
