Training is key to success and during the winter months we need to focus on our weaknesses. Train hard and be sure you have your membership status up to date as you earn your MH title and of course your 4 Master passes to qualify for the upcoming MAI.

The board of directors is still in the planning stages for the upcoming MAI in Carnation, WA but here are some of the details for the upcoming MAI.

Date of the MAI is June 9th-June 16th, 2024.

The event will be held on the Snoqualmie Valley Retriever Grounds near Carnation, WA.

To enter check EntryExpress.net. Look under Washington State events.

Entries will open March 1st and close by April 1st, 2024.

Currently, there is only one set of judges listed on the premium but if entries exceed the limit of a single flight we will add a second flight and judges, with Carol Hynes and Mark Watson.

An email was sent to the membership on the positions open on the board of directors for 2024 and include:

The office of President – Fred Nusbickel will not be seeking another term. This is a four-year term.

Vice President, West Central Region – Dave Christianson will not seek another term. This is a four-year term.

Director Western Region – Julie Cairns will not seek another term. This is a two-year term.

Director Central Region - Wilson "Boogie" LeJeune will be seeking another two-year term.

You can send nominations for any of the above open positions to your regional director. Note: you must live in your region to be nominated for that regions open position, exception is the President position.

Only persons who meet the definition of "Amateur" as defined by the American Kennel Club regulations pertaining to retriever then in force shall be eligible for election as an officer or director. Those elected will take office 30 days after the annual meeting.

ANNUAL MEETING/NEW BUSINESS

Official notice of the annual meeting will be sent out by April 30th (40 days prior) and the deadline to submit "New Business" is 55 days before the annual meeting which is April 15th.

TIME TO JOIN OR RENEW YOUR 2024-2025 MEMBERSHIP

Annual memberships are valid from the time of purchase through February 28, 2025. Ideally, for all your master passes to count, your annual membership should be purchased by March 1st of each year.

There are 3 types of annual memberships:

Amateur Membership

- Annual membership for amateur individuals is \$50 per year
- Annual membership for amateur and family is \$55 per year

Annual Club Membership


• Club memberships can be purchased each year at the cost of \$50. This gives club the option to vote on MARC business meetings and MARC elections. 1 vote per club

Associate Annual Membership


• Professional trainer individuals, sponsors, etc. that wish to support MARC. No voting privileges allowed.







Eastern Region Trends
